COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

In 1906 the Associated Gas & Electric Company, a utility holding company, was formed to consolidate a group of gas and electric companies under one umbrella organization. Their main office was located in Ithaca, and the oldest company in the association was the Ithaca Gas Light Company, established in 1852. It went bankrupt in the early 1940s and under the court's supervision was broken up into smaller companies.

This collection contains publications of the Associated Gas and Electric Company from 1924-1937, and bankruptcy materials from 1941-1945.
