COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection is comprised of newspaper articles, correspondence, books, studies, nature guides, maps, and other documents relating to the life of Carl Crandall (1890-1969) and the Ithaca area during his lifetime. Carl Crandall was a very active and prominent public figure of the Ithaca community and Cornell University. He served for a long career as Ithaca City's Civil Engineer starting in 1916, and was a faculty member in Cornell's school of Civil Engineering as well as its director in 1948. In addition, Crandall was an executive officer of the Finger Lakes Park Commission in 1961. He also consulted for a wide variety of civil engineering projects around the country.
