COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection contains business records of Capt. John Frees (sic) and W.B. Freese from the late 19th century. In box 1 they concern shipments of coal from Lehigh Valley Railroad cars transshipped on Cayuga Lake and through the barge canal on various boats in the 1890s. Home ports of the various boats range over the whole state of New York, from Ithaca to Brooklyn to Little Falls.
