## COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The Ithaca Business and Professional Women's Club was founded in 1941 and certified in 1994 by BPW/USA as a 2000 club. Its objective was to provide "opportunities for leadership training, career development, legislative and political involvement and networking." In 2002 the club was disbanded because of "lack of participation and interest in leadership roles and committee activities, declining membership and low attendance at monthly meetings." The group decided to continue by meeting several times annually as the Ithaca BPW Alumni to socialize and network.
