### COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection contains information regarding the Ithaca HOURS monetary system from its inception in 1991 to 2001. Created by a former Ithaca resident, Paul Glover, this bartering system utilized scrip that represented an hour of work as the equivalent of \$10. The effects of this system were extensive. Millions of dollars of transactions have taken place without any national currency having to be used, thereby keeping the financial benefit local. This system was created to promote cooperation, not competition, in the local economy.

This collection contains information regarding the daily operations of the HOURS organization, such as financial tracking and requests to accept this system. The production of the money is detailed through sketches by creator Paul Glover and samples of all HOUR denominations from the 1/8 HOUR to the 2 1/2 HOUR. Also contained are the lists displaying participating businesses and residents, as well as extensive internal and external correspondence. The collection also includes information on the grants and loans given by the HOURS organization over the course of this ten-year period.

The collection includes thousands of local, national and international newspaper clippings, magazine articles and journal publications mentioning the HOURS. There are also transcripts of radio segments and television broadcasts, as well as several scholarly works utilizing Ithaca HOURS as a case study for research on local monetary systems. Finally, this collection features information about the spread of local monetary systems inspired by Ithaca HOURS. Since the beginning of the Ithaca HOURS in 1991, over 80 cities in North America and as far away as China and Japan have embraced this system of keeping money and talents local.
