

Guide to the **Finger Lakes State Park Records Collection**

The History Center in Tompkins County

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COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection contains records of the Emergency Conservation Work (ECW), later the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC), in the Finger Lakes State Parks, beginning in 1934 and continuing to 1941. Records of project work done in Buttermilk Falls State Park, Enfield Glen (later Robert H. Treman State Park) and Taughannock Falls State Park, along with camp inspection reports, meal menus and other correspondence. There are also xerographic copies of photographs, from the National Archives, of Parks projects during this period. Also included are annual reports of the Finger Lakes State Parks Commission from its Secretary to the Legislature, for years 1927 to 1965.
