COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection contains materials concerning the travels of Ithacans Edna and Lela Gross from approximately 1907 to 1960. The collection includes three scrapbooks created by Edna Gross which contain detailed descriptions of her travels, as well as photos, sketches, and some other souvenirs. There are two scrapbooks describing Edna and Lela's travels to Canada and one describing their travels to New England. The collection also contains a certificate stating that Lela Gross crossed the Arctic Circle in 1960.
