COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The *Oral Histories of Tompkins County* contain over 200 interviews collected from Tompkins County residents between the years of 2008-2021. We are in the process of transcribing all interviews, and updating the collections to be more accessible for the public. The majority of our interviews were recorded as part of specific initiatives or class projects. In 2021 we created a new category of Oral History Collections within our holdings to group interviews that share gender, racial, ethnic, and cultural themes within their narratives. Interviews in this Finding Aid may be listed in multiple places as selections of their original project, and other broader themed collections. This Finding Aid is a guide to the interview transcripts in the Oral History Collection paper archives and does not represent the entire Oral History Collection, whose interviews have not all been transcribed.
